

ANSWER

The apical 4-chamber view shows dilated atria with normal-sized, normally contracting ventricles. Both ventricular apices are obliterated. The parasternal long-axis view shows almost plastered posterior mitral leaflet with eccentric, posteriorly directed jet of significant mitral regurgitation.

These echo findings are quite classical of hypereosinophilic syndrome.
